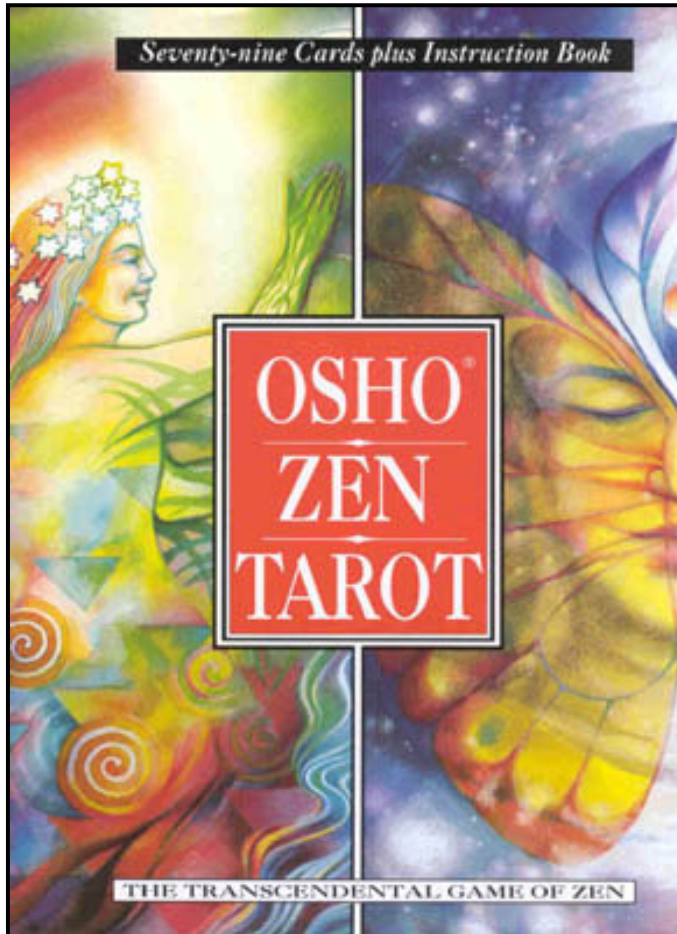

Traditionally, tarot cards are used as a method of answering questions about life, a way to satisfy a longing to know about one's past and future.

The Osho Zen Tarot focuses on gaining an understanding of the here and now, through the ancient wisdom of Zen. It enables us to turn our attention from outside events to discover the clarity of understanding our innermost wishes.

The Osho Zen Tarot celebrates life in all its dimensions, and doesn't make moral or ideological judgments about what is "good" and what is "bad." It sees difficulties and problems in human life as basically the products of unawareness. And when they arise, they are reminders to bring more alertness to who we are and what we are doing. Another way of putting it is that if we stumble against the furniture in a dark room, bruise ourselves, knock over a vase and break it, it's not because we are somehow intrinsically evil or wrong; it's because we haven't switched on the light.
